The American **Real Estate** and Urban **Economics** Association (AREUEA) invites you to submit a paper for AREUEA's 49<sup>th</sup> Conference held in conjunction with the Allied Social Science Association (ASSA) meetings. The conference will be held January 3-5, 2014 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The 49<sup>th</sup> AREUEA-ASSA Conference will consist of approximately twenty-three paper and/or panel sessions. Other features include a special program for doctoral students and social networking events.

The topical focus of the conference sessions will include theoretical, empirical, and policy research in real estate economics, real estate finance, and urban economics.

All papers **must be** submitted via the AREUEA website at: <https://www.areuea.org/members/papers/>.

Additionally:

1. At least one author must be a member of AREUEA in order to submit the paper and present at the conference (AREUEA member user id & password are required to submit a paper).
2. The paper cannot be submitted to or under consideration for inclusion with any other ASSA participating organization.
3. Only one paper submission per author except in instances in which a co-author would otherwise be precluded from submitting a paper.
4. Submit your **completed** manuscript no later than April 1, 2013. Well-developed abstracts will also be considered but preference will be given to completed papers. Beginning with the 2014 call for papers (for the 2015 sessions) **only** completed papers will be considered.
5. The contact author will be notified no later than June 15 of acceptance or rejection of the submission.
6. Should your paper be accepted for the program, by December 1, 2013:
  - You must provide your session chair and discussant a copy of your paper, in addition to Elizabeth Laffitte ([elaffitte@cob.fsu.edu](mailto:elaffitte@cob.fsu.edu)).
  - Your paper will be posted to the conference website prior to the conference.
7. You must provide the following information for submission:
  - Title of paper and two or three key words indicating the topic;
  - Corresponding author and institutional affiliation;
  - Complete address, telephone, facsimile, and email address;
  - (Contact & institutional affiliation information is also requested for each additional author.)*
