- The American Real Estate and Urban Economics Association (AREUEA) invites the submission of papers for the 2003 AREUEA International Conference.
- The 2003 AREUEA International Conference will be held in Cracow, Poland on June 15th-17th, 2003. There will be two full days of sessions following a kick-off reception on the evening of June 15th.
- Those interested in having a paper considered for presentation should submit a completed manuscript with an abstract, or a well-developed abstract, no later than **February 1, 2003**. Papers and abstracts should include a list of references that is as complete as possible. All submissions should include the full name(s) of the author(s) and their professional affiliation(s). The corresponding author should be clearly identified with information on his or her: current address, telephone number, fax number, and an email address. This information should appear only on the title page of the submission. At least one author must be a member of AREUEA. The abstract page should include a list of keywords indicating the contents of the article.
- Papers, abstracts of papers, and participation requests must be submitted through the AREUEA website by visiting www.areuea.org and following the Conference link and sub link Call for Papers.

 - Individuals interested in serving as session chairs or as discussants are also asked to indicate their preferences to the program chair by February 1, 2003.
- Travel, lodging and program information will be posted shortly.
