



## 22nd Annual AREUEA Doctoral Session 2009

**What** The AREUEA Doctoral Session provides students in real estate and related fields with insights to topics such as career planning, publishing, and research. Selected students can present their work and all participants can network with peers, journal editors, established Ph.D.s and potential mentors.
