

Childress Klein Distinguished Professor of Real Estate and Urban Economics

The Belk College of Business at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte is seeking a distinguished academic to fill a tenured position as the Childress Klein Professor of Real Estate and Urban Economics. The appointee shall have experience and credentials as a teacher and scholar commensurate with the rank of full or associate professor in the Belk College of Business. In the instance where the candidate is hired as an associate professor, the title of "Childress Klein Scholar of Real Estate and Urban Economics" will be used.

Qualifications:

- Ph.D. in one of the following areas: real estate, finance, economics or a closely related field from an accredited university;
- Record of sustained scholarship and international reputation commensurate with appointment to an endowed professorship;
- Teaching and research interests in one or more of the following areas: real estate, finance, or urban economics;
- Demonstrated record of teaching excellence at the undergraduate, graduate, and executive levels;
- Strong communication and relationship-building skills with students, faculty, alumni, and the local business community; and,
- Ability and willingness to represent the Belk College to the Charlotte regional business community. Teaching load and salary will be competitive with such positions at research universities.
