Assistant Professor Qualifications:

Basic qualifications: Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree or be enrolled in an accredited doctoral program at the time of application. *Additional Qualifications:* Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in a closely-related field or have advanced to Ph.D. candidacy and will complete the doctoral degree or equivalent degree within 6 months of start date. *Preferred qualifications:* Applicants whose research, teaching, and service has prepared them to contribute to diversity and inclusion in higher education and to the Haas School's strategic focus on innovation, broadly defined, are encouraged to highlight these points in their application.

Associate/Full Professor Qualifications:

Basic qualifications: Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in a closely-related field. *Additional Qualifications:* Applicants must be currently, or have been previously, employed as an Associate or Full Professor. *Preferred qualifications:* Applicants whose research, teaching, and service has prepared them to contribute to diversity and inclusion in higher education or to the Haas School's strategic focus on innovation, broadly defined, are encouraged to highlight these points in their application.

Assistant Professor Application Requirements:

Applicants should upload the following materials: cover letter stating future research plans and interests, a curriculum vitae, job market paper, and arrange for three letters of reference to be uploaded. Optional materials may include additional working papers or publications, a statement of teaching, and teaching evaluations. We strongly recommend including a statement of candidate's contributions to diversity addressing past and/or potential contributions through research, teaching and/or service (this statement will be required of candidates invited to campus interviews). Associate/Full Professor Application Requirements:

Applicants should upload the following materials: curriculum vitae and a research paper. Optional but recommended materials include cover letter, other research papers, brief statements of research and teaching interests, and teaching evaluations. We also strongly recommend that all applicants submit a statement of

contributions to diversity through research, teaching and/or service. (This statement is required of candidates invited for campus interviews.)
