Teaching is expected both at the undergraduate and graduate levels, including in the Master of Science in Finance program and in M.B.A. courses in Finance. Candidates should have a Ph.D. or D.B.A. in Finance or Real Estate. Individuals near completion of their doctoral degree will be considered.
