Additionally, candidates with Master's Degree must document exceptional accomplishments in Real Estate or related area and must be approved for a terminal degree exception before hire. Preference will be given to candidates with strong communication skills and the potential for excellent teaching. The position is renewable based on performance, and promotion to Senior Lecturer is possible after six years of service. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications.
