

JOB OPENING: Postdoctoral Fellow (Research Track)

Job Description:

The postdoctoral fellow is expected to be an independent researcher and scholar in the urban and real estate field. The candidate is expected to have an excellent level of research performance where excellence is defined as “an independent ability to publish in reputable journals and to conduct good quality scientific research”. It is also expected that the candidate can contribute to the department research programs.

Qualifications/ Experience Requirements:

- A PhD, or equivalent, in a relevant discipline
- A strong indication of research achievements or publications in urban and real estate
- A demonstrable plan for high-quality research in the immediate future and the longer term
- A commitment to collegiality and an ability to work as a part of a multidisciplinary academic team
- Good writing and communication skills

It is desirable if the applicant can show evidence of strong publication track records and research leadership experiences.
