Position

The position is effective starting from fall 2021, pending available funding. Responsibilities include effectively teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in real estate, developing a stream of quality research and externally funded research projects, as well as fulfilling professional and university service responsibilities. The department is an academically diverse, research-oriented group of 13 full-time faculty members. Qualifications

Ph.D. in real estate or Ph.D. in finance and evidence of academic training or quality research in real estate is required. Demonstrated teaching effectiveness and strong research record are required.
