Minimum Qualifications:

- Status as academically qualified, under both SACS and AACSB standards, to teach at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Record of effective teaching of college level real estate courses;
- Experience teaching commercial real estate and property management courses;
- Experience teaching remote, online or hybrid courses;
- Record of peer-reviewed presentations at major academic real estate conferences and high quality peer-reviewed discipline-specific publications appropriate for an R1 research university;
- Real estate industry experience.
